Flag Facts:

Did you know that unless properly illuminated, your flag should not be displayed at night and lowered no later than sunset.

The circular emblem on the State flags is called a “roundel”.

The design of our first National flag was chosen from 30,000 designs submitted in a worldwide competition in 1901 as part of our federation.

The half of the flag that is furthest from the flag pole is called the “fly”.

What is the meaning of the National flag flown upside down? If it's upside down, it's a distress signal.

What does the seven points on the large star on the National flag represent? The six States and one territory.
